



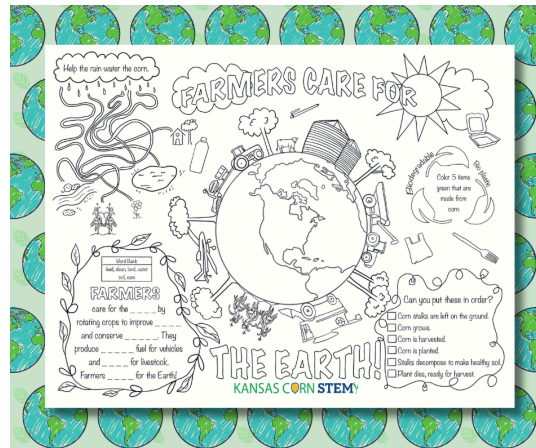
Welcome to the Kansas Corn STEM March 2026 Newsletter!
